**\*\* To check the reasonableness of your grade, distinguish the difference between getting a high C or a low C, a high B or a low B, etc. Average your estimated exam letter grades, counting the Final Exam grade twice.** In estimating your grade, all your quizzes together will count 100 points, as much as a midterm exam. To broadly estimate your quiz grade (approximately 2/3 inclass, 1/3 online), compare your inclass quiz scores to the average quiz scores your Recitation Instructor gave you when they handed back your quizzes. If you were consistently near the average, your inclass quiz grade can be estimated as being a C, well above average most of the time would be estimated as a B or A, etc. For your Online quiz grade, using 85-70-50-40 to broadly estimate the letter grade would be close. The final grade distribution and grades were determined as described in the ground rules for the course.
