

## INFORMATION FOR TUTOR APPLICANTS

### **READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CAREFULLY.**

The Department of Mathematics does not hire tutors. Instead, the Department of Mathematics compiles a list of names of qualified people interested in tutoring.

**As this is not employment by Purdue University, please keep in mind that if you are an international student, federal law prohibits you from outside employment. Therefore, you may not apply to be on the tutor list.**

If you are interested in having your name added to the Department of Mathematics Tutor List, complete and return the attached one-page application **along with a transcript of your grades (transcript should include everything after high school)** to the receptionist in MATH 835. (A photocopy of the grade transcript(s) is acceptable.) If you are a **current** math graduate student, no transcript is necessary.

The Mathematics Department online tutor list will be updated frequently during the first few weeks of the semester, and will be updated occasionally during the remainder of the semester. Note that this means your email address and phone number will be published online unless you specify otherwise. ***Your home address is NEVER published.***

***Please be sure to report any changes (especially phone number and email address changes) to the information on this application as soon as possible to Terri Kepner in the Math main office/Math 835 or email [tkepner@math.purdue.edu](mailto:tkepner@math.purdue.edu)***

Students will contact you throughout the semester. As long as your name remains on the list, you are expected to return their telephone calls, even if you are no longer accepting students for tutoring. **Should your plans change and you no longer wish to be listed**, you must contact the receptionist and request that your name be removed from the tutor list.

**NOTE:** Your application will be valid for the Fall 2011 session. Even though you were previously listed as a tutor, your name will not automatically reappear on this list from one year to the next. A new application must be filled out each Fall with the new academic year. However, if you were on the tutor list in the Fall and wish to stay on the list in the following Spring semester, you simply need to notify the receptionist of this.
