- 2) There are fifteen multiple-choice problems on the exam. The exam will be machine graded. No partial credit will be given.
- 3) Any formulas from chapter 4 that are needed will be provided on the exam.
- 4) The exam is self-explanatory. No questions will be allowed unless a student believes there is a typographical or printing error.

- 6) Exams from previous semesters are available on the web page. These are good for review purposes, but not a guarantee of what will or will not be on the exam.
- 7) Students must bring a PHOTO ID with them to the exam. It is recommended that students arrive early
- 8) Students are to bring a NON-GRAPHING calculator with them to the exam.
- 9) No one will be allowed to leave the exam site for the first 20 minutes of the exam. Students arriving after 20 minutes will be allowed to take the make-up exam. If they arrived late for a non-valid reason, a grade penalty of 30 points will be deducted from the make-up exam score.
- 10) A student must contact Joe Chen in MA B15 IMMEDIATELY if some emergency prevents them from taking the exam.
