** You will have a quiz at least twice per week starting Friday, August 29 (there will only be one quiz given the first week). The quiz is a short, 5-7 minute, 2-3 question quiz at the end of the class period. The only exceptions to days that a score will not take place are the optional review days before each exam and during dead week (no quiz, but homework will be hand written and collected the last week of class).

You should give a quiz on days immediately after each exam on the material discussed that day and you can allow students to use their notes to help them on those days only. You will need to have a minimum of 27 scores given for in class work (mostly quizzes, but homework during the last week)
