- 2) There are fifteen multiple-choice problems on the exam. The exam will be machine graded. No partial credit will be given.
- 3) The exam is self-explanatory. No questions will be allowed unless a student believes there is a typographical or printing error.
- 4) The following are appropriate Review Problems:  
page 156: 7-10, 17, 19-22, 23, 25, 27, 33, 34, 38-40, 43-45, 48, 50, 52, 57, 59, 60, 66-68, 80-82  
page 233: 5-7, 9, 11, 13-15, 16, 20
- 5) Exams from previous semesters are available on the web page These are good for review purposes, but not a guarantee of what will or will not be the exam.
- 6) Students must bring a PHOTO ID with them to the exam. It is recommended that students arrive early.
