

Following are the approximate letter grade cut-offs from exam 1:

Overall average for Exam 1: 70

A 90 - 100

B 81 - 89

C 65 - 80

D 50 - 64

F 0 - 49

Also, this curve should not be used as an absolute determination of what letter grade you have in the course. It is provided for your own information and as an indication of how your score compares to others. Also consider where in the range your score falls. For example, a score of 80 could be regarded as a C or a B (it is very close to a B). Your **TOTAL NUMBER OF POINTS** earned during the semester determines your final letter grade in the course.

The average on this exam was higher than typical. If this continues all semester, higher final grades will be given at the end of the semester. Since we don't know if this will continue or not, the letter grade estimates given above take into account that the exam might have been a little easier than normal. In other words, if you got an 80 on exam 1, you can consider that a B also but a very low B (it would be in the C+/B- range).
