
Calculator Policy

CALCULATORS

<u>No calculators are allowed on quizzes and exams until after exam 2. After Exam 2</u> is completed, a non-graphing, non-programmable, <u>1-line scientific calculator</u> is required for many problems on the quizzes and exams (a 1-line TI-30 calculator is recommended, but other 1-line scientific calculators are also allowed). Multiple line calculators are <u>not</u> <u>allowed</u> on quizzes and exams. We will not allow the sharing of calculators with other students.
