

Span Plan Adult Student Services (SPAN)

SPAN is a program to assist nontraditional students with their programs or classes while a student at Purdue. A nontraditional student is defined by SPAN as a student who meets any three of the following criteria.

- A student who experienced a minimum three year break between completing high school and attending higher education
- A student who experienced an interruption of two or more years while pursuing higher education
- A student who is married and/or a parent
