This allows students to ask questions about the homework in class and still complete it within a few hours.

All paper homework assignments are due in class when the class hands in the assignments. I do not accept them early, late, in my mailbox, under my office door, or before class. Do not give them to someone in class to hand in for you. Do not hand the homework to me at the start of class and leave.

No quizzes may be made-up or taken early/late.

Exams 1, 2, and 3 are given in class, during the normal class time. Note: Regular exams will be in *either MATH 175 or MTHW 210*, not the regular classroom. The final exam is two hours and will be given on either August 1st, 2nd, or 3rd. The date, time, and location will be announced later in the summer.
