On problems for which you use your calculator, write on the exam paper what you type into the calculator in order to receive full credit.

The final exam for Math 13800 will take place at 10:30 am on Monday, December 9<sup>th</sup> in UNIV 119. You will have 2 hours for the exam.

The exam will have 18 questions. Ten multiple-choice questions will be worth 7 points each. Eight open-answer questions will be worth 10 points each. Partial credit will be given on the open-answer questions only. Six questions will be from lessons 30-35. The remaining questions are from the first 29 lessons.

Helpful hint: the answer "None of the above" is sometimes used, but not often.

Non-graphing calculators will be allowed. Cell phones may NOT be used as a calculator and you may not borrow a calculator. It is good to arrive 15 minutes early. Of course, bring your photo ID.
