

The final exam for Math 13900 will take place at 8:00 am on Monday, December 9, 2013 in PHYS 223.

You will have 2 hours for the exam.

The exam will have 18 questions. Ten multiple-choice questions will be worth 7 points each. Eight open-answer questions will be worth 10 points each. Partial credit will be given on the open-answer questions only. Five questions will be from lessons 30-35. The remaining questions are from the first 30 lessons.

Helpful hint: the answer “None of the above” is sometimes used, but not often.

No calculators will be allowed. It is good to arrive 15 minutes early. Of course, bring your photo ID as well as your ruler, protractor, and compass.
