Exams 1, 2 and 3 are given in class, during the normal class time, and will be a combination of open answer and multiple choice questions. The **Final Exam** will be given between July 31st and August 2nd, and is a two hour exam. The date, time and location will be announced later in the summer.

Grades: There are 600 total points in the course; 70 points homework, 30 points quizzes, three 100 point midterm exams, and a 200 point final exam. Notice that exams are worth 500 of the 600 points.

Total points = 70*(Homework %) + 30*(Quiz %) + Total Exam points

Two homework scores and one quiz score will be dropped at the end of the session. Since attendance is very important, additional scores will require documentation to be excused.
