- Practice problems for the Final Exam are available on the course web page. However, do not focus solely on these problems to review. Be sure to also look at all the homework problems, the quizzes, your instructor's examples from class and your midterm exams.
- Remember to bring a one-line calculator to the final. We cannot share calculators at the final, and cell phones cannot be used as calculators. (Cell phones must be turned off and put away during the final.)
- There is no partial credit on the Final Exam. You should circle your 25 answers carefully in the exam booklet itself.
