Quizzes will be given two or three times a week and will not be announced ahead of time.

There will be about 14 quizzes this summer. Your lowest quiz score will be dropped.

Exams 1, 2 and 3 are given in class, during the normal class time, and will be a combination of open answer and multiple choice questions. The **Final Exam** will be given August 6th, 7th, or 8th, and is a two hour exam. The date, time and location of the Final Exam will be announced later in the summer.

Grades: There are 600 total points in the course; 70 points homework, 30 points quizzes, three 100 point midterm exams, and a 200 point final exam. Notice that exams are worth 500 of the 600 points.

Total points = 70*(Homework %) + 30*(Quiz %) + Total Exam points

Two homework scores and one quiz score will be dropped at the end of the session. Since attendance is very important, additional scores will require documentation to be excused.
