## **Quiz Policies and Procedures**

- 1. Studying the lesson notes and completing your homework by the deadline prior to class is the best way to prepare for a quiz.
- 2. Copy the problem and complete your work on paper. Before turning the paper in, fold the paper lengthwise and write or print your name on the outside of the paper.
- 3. Only a TI-30XA (TI-30Xa) calculator I allowed. Calculators cannot be shared.
- 4. All cell phones must be off and out of sight.
- 5. The only things allowed on the desk top should be a single sheet of paper, a pencil (or pen), and your TI-30XA calculator.
- 6. If you cannot see the quiz that is being projected, please sit closer to the front.
- 7. If I see students talking to each other during a quiz, I could assume there is cheating.

- 8. Do not look around the room during the quiz; if I see students looking 'around', I could assume there is cheating.
- 9. Do not turn in anyone else's quiz for them. Each student must submit his/her own quiz.
- 10. Partial credit may be awarded, assuming the work shown is relevant to the quiz problem(s).
- 11. When you are finished with your quiz, turn it in only to the instructor. While packing-up your belongings, turn your quiz upside down so it is not visible to others. If you want to wait for a friend, wait outside the classroom.
- 12. If you don't know the answer to a quiz problem or how to determine the answer, don't cheat. Take the score you earn and try to do better the next time.

A student who is caught cheating may lose ALL of his/her quiz points for the semester, and will be reported to the Office of the Dean of Students for further disciplinary action.
