The first time the student accesses WebAssign in the Fall 2018, he/she will be prompted to create or link to a Cengage account. This is a one-time process, and the students will continue to access WebAssign using their Purdue Career Account credentials.
(2) Students should not login through the company site- they will not be able to do their homework.

## Student Account Access

- Once you have officially enrolled through Purdue Banner, your name will automatically show up in the corresponding WebAssign course section after a successfully login from WebAssign @ Purdue Login Page http://www.webassign.net/purdue/login.html
- If you change sections, you need to inform your instructor/TA in order to have your records transferred. The turn-around time is about one or two days. Please be patient.
- You have a two-week trial period before you are required to enter the online access code.
(2) It is your responsibility to make sure that you obtain the access code by the end of the two-week trial period.

(i) For all courses only the Enhanced WebAssign Access Code is required. A physical copy of the book is optional. Stweart's ebook comes with the WebAssign access code. The ebook of Boyce and Diprima is available with the WebAssign access code, but it is optional.

## Purchasing of WebAssign Online Access

1. One can buy the bundle book plus access code at local bookstores for all courses.
2. One can buy the online access code directly from the WebAssign account page. The access code comes with the ebook for Stewart. The access code does not come with Boyce and Diprima, but one can also buy access to the ebook.
3. One can buy the access codes from amazon.com (avoid buying from third-party sellers).

- For Stewart, you can choose between multiple or single semesters access. Online access to Stewart automatically comes with an ebook.
- Note that the multiple semester access code locks in the edition of the book.
- For Boyce \& DiPrima the access code is valid for one semester. Ebook is available, but optional.


## Tips for Entering Your Answers in WebAssign

- For questions asking for numerics and mathematical expressions, you have by default $\mathbf{1 0 0}$ chances.
- For multiple choice (True/False) questions, you have only a limited number (one) of chances.
- Whenever possible, always enter the exact mathematical expressions (by using the math palette provided).
- For numerical answers, as a rule of thumb, enter at least four decimal places (or four significant digits).
- Capital and small letter variables are treated differently: for example: $\Pi$ (Pi) vs $\pi$ (pi); $\Phi$ (Phi) vs $\phi$ (phi); $\Theta$ (Theta) vs $\theta$ (theta) and so forth.
- Questions which prompt for the open or close brackets "(", ")", "[", "]" are treated as True/False questions and hence allow only one chance.
