

The Final Exam will be on MyLab, just like your previous exams. Here are the things you need to know.

1. The exam has 21 questions. 15 of which are multiple-choice.
2. The exam is a two-hour exam.
3. The exam window opens at 12 am on Wednesday, 12/9 and closes at 9 am on Friday, 12/11.
4. The Final Exam is comprehensive.
5. You are expected to finish the exam in one sitting. But just like with exam 2, you can exit and resume the exam later if you want. However, the questions you have seen in a previous session will not be accessible when you return to the exam.
6. You must abide by the following rules while taking the exam
 - a. **You may use the textbook and your own notes. You may not share notes with anyone**
 - b. **NO calculators**
 - c. **NO phones, except when using Boilerkey**
 - d. **NO outside help of ANY KIND**
 - e. **NO communications with ANYONE by ANY MEANS**
7. While you take the exam, we expect you to work out **ALL** the problems on paper. To verify that the answers you put into MyLab are your own work, **you are required to submit your written work (scan or pictures) on Brightspace within 2 hours after you complete the exam on MyLab.**
8. **We may deduct points from your exam if there are significant discrepancies between your MyLab exam and your written work.**
9. Your written work will not be graded. But we will use it to decide whether to give you a higher grade if your grade is on a borderline. **You will NOT receive borderline considerations if no written work is submitted (or is late).**
10. Please do not discuss the exam with anyone until **Wednesday, 12/16.**
