MA16010 Different Class Structures

Traditional:

- a. Traditional class meets three times a week for 50 minutes each.
- b. The structure of a traditional class is the usual structure that one would expect. Instructors lecture for the majority of the class time.
- c. Graded work includes exams, quizzes and homework.

IMPACT:

a. IMPACT class meets twice a week for 50 minutes each.

b. Students preview the new material by watching the lecture videos and/or reading the etext before class. In class, students spend most of the time doing hands on problem solving. Students receive immediate feedback and help in class.

c. Graded work includes exams, worksheets and homework.

Notes:

- a. For all students, traditional or IMPACT, there are free tutoring services available on campus, as well as Piazza, an online discussion forum.
- b. Exams and homework assignments are the same for all students, regardless of the class structure.
- c. As far as the total time spent on the course, there is no significant difference for the different class structures.
