


## What is SI?

- SI sessions are peer-led group study sessions, where your SI leader will guide you through activities, and you will collaborate with other students to solve problems and find solutions.
- When a student is able to explain information to their peers, they are creating an even stronger grasp on the information, which is why 1 hour of SI is equal to 2 hours to individual studying.

## How to access online SI sessions?


1. Go to <https://purdue.brightspace.com/d2l/home/6824> and access with your boiler key.

2. Click on Summer Supplemental Instruction

#### 4. Click on MA 16010

- In order to attend the SI session or office hour, simply click on the session link at the correct session time.

##### What should I expect from SI?

- SI sessions will reflect the same in-person format: your SI leader will guide you through activities, and you will collaborate with fellow peers to solve problems and find solutions.
- An SI Leader's role is to facilitate the discussion that will lead to you and your peers figuring out the answer, so often times SI Leaders will redirect questions instead of just answering it themselves.
- When a student is able to explain information to their peers, they are creating an even stronger grasp on the information, which is why 1 hour of SI is equal to 2 hours to individual studying.

##### How is online SI different from in-person SI?

- They are basically the same!
- SI Leaders will still facilitate collaboration between you and your peers in an online environment, and give you problems and activities to give you more practice with the course material.
- SI Leaders will hold 2-4 sessions a week, as well as one office hour.

##### Do I need to know how to use WebEx?

- Nope! Your SI leaders will be trained on how to use WebEx and will facilitate the entire session.
