• SI sessions are peer-led group study sessions, where your SI leader will guide you through activities, and you will collaborate with other students to solve problems and find solutions.


• When a student is able to explain information to their peers, they are creating an even stronger grasp on the information, which is why 1 hour of SI is equal to 2 hours to individual studying.


How to access online SI sessions?
