Following are the grade ranges for exam 2. The reason we have included "+" and "-" letter grades is so you will keep in mind where in a range your particular score falls (for example, a score of 90 would basically be considered either an A or B .). These grade ranges should give you a better indication of translating your score to a letter grade. We do not give plus or minus grades at the end of the semester. Also, keep in mind that although these are good estimates, they are estimates only and that final letter grades in the course are determined by total number of points.
