- 1 Students need access to **My Lab Math** for all online homework assignments.
 - a **My Lab Math** is accessed via **BRIGHTSPACE**. (Do not login via the Pearson website)
 - b There is a 2-week free trial period for **My Lab Math**.
 - c Students will need to purchase access before the 2-week trial period expires. It is probably better to buy a code directly from Pearson within the course link.
 - d Our textbook is also used for the subsequent calculus courses MA16200 and MA26100.
 - e Students who have previously purchased multi-term access do not need to purchase access again.
