- Homework is typically due before 11:59pm on Friday. Early submissions are helpful.
- Problems will come from the **4**th edition of our textbook (available online for free) as well as problems not in the textbook.
- There are **True/False** questions designed to test your grasp of certain definitions, concepts, or theorems. These types of questions require a plausible *justification* of your answer either in the form of a short explanation, an example, or a counterexample. Simply writing "**True**" or "**False**" is not sufficient.
- Calculators or computers are not needed on the homework sets unless specifically stated. (Calculators are not needed in this course and are not permitted on any exams or quizzes.)
- You may discuss problems with classmates but turn in your own work, otherwise it is considered cheating.
- Homework papers should be scanned and submitted as a *single* .pdf file to **GRADESCOPE** (accessed via Brightspace). If you don't have a scanner, there are phone apps that can be used. Please write clearly. Also, to help our grader, please use a descriptive title for your file. Something like HW-01-Jane-Doe.pdf is sufficient.
