

MA 366 Tips for Submitting Homework via **GRADESCOPE**

- Homework is typically due before **11:59pm on Friday**. Early submissions are helpful to our grader. Do not wait until the last minute to submit homework. Late homeworks are not accepted.
- Problems will come from the **12th** edition of our textbook as well as problems not in the textbook.
- Calculators or computers are not needed on the homework sets unless specifically stated. (Calculators are not needed in this course and are not permitted on any exams.)
- You may discuss problems with classmates but submit your own work, otherwise it is considered cheating and we are required to report it to the Office of the Dean of Students (**ODOS**).
- Homework papers should be scanned and submitted as a **single .pdf** file to **GRADESCOPE**. If you don't have a scanner, there are phone apps that can be used. Please write clearly (you may use $\text{\LaTeX}$ if you wish). Also, please use a descriptive title for your file. A title of the form **HW-01-Jane-Doe.pdf** is sufficient and will help our grader.
