

Instructions on Exam 1: MA 165 - Fall 2022

Basic Information

- (1) **Format:** Exam 1 will be given as an in-person evening exam and in multiple choice format.
- (2) **Day:** Wednesday, September 21, 2022.
- (3) **Time:** 6:30 PM - 7:30 PM.

WARNING: You are supposed to arrive at Elliott Hall of Music 15 minutes prior to the starting time of the exam. That is to say, you should come to EHM by 6:15 PM so that we can start the exam at 6:30 PM sharp. Between 6:15 PM and 6:30 PM, you will fill out the necessary personal information on the scantron sheet and sign on the 2nd page of the exam booklet. (Without the signature, we will NOT grade your exam. See the attached first two cover pages of the exam.) If you come at 6:30 PM, you may not have the full 60 minutes to work on the questions. We will NOT allow you to fill out the personal information after the exam is over at 7:30 PM.

- (4) **Duration:** 60 minutes.
- (5) **Place and Seating Assignment:** You go to the Elliott Hall of Music. There is no individual seating assignment. However, you should go to the specified area which is assigned to your recitation instructor (i.e., your TA) (See the attached seating chart.), and then grab a seat according to the instruction of your recitation instructor (your TA).
- (6) **Calculator Policy:** No calculator is allowed for Exam 1.
- (7) **Academic Dishonesty:** If we find you are involved in an action of academic dishonesty (this includes helping the other students during the exam and/or using a calculator), you will receive an automatic 0 for this exam.
- (8) **Special Accommodation:** If you require special accommodations, the exam will be administered through DRC. If you have further questions, please contact Stephanie <foster80@purdue.edu>.
- (9) **Exam Booklet and Scantron Sheet:** There are 2 versions of Exam 1, Version 01 (Green Booklet) and Version 02 (Orange Booklet). Except for the order of the questions and the multiple choices for the answers, the contents of the two versions are identical. Make sure you match the color of the exam booklet and that of the scantron sheet.

You submit BOTH exam booklet and scantron sheet at the end of the exam. We will return the exam booklet in the following Recitation Class, while we keep the scantron sheet for the record. If there is discrepancy between what marked in the exam booklet and what you marked on the scantron sheet, your final score will be determined based on what you marked on the scantron sheet.

- (10) **Alternating Exam:** If you have a conflict with the scheduled Exam 1 (or if you happen to fall ill on the day of the exam), please contact BOTH your lecturer and your recitation instructor (TA) ASAP. You have to receive an e-mail message from your lecturer in order to take the make-up exam (Version Alternate). Your recitation instructor does NOT have an authority to approve your makeup exam. Once you receive a message of approval from your lecturer, then contact Casey "McDonald, Casey Ann" jmcdon196@purdue.edu, to make an arrangement for the make-up. (She has some specific days/times available for you to take the make-up exam.)
- (11) **Regrading Request:** You may request manual regrading of the scantron sheet. The request should be addressed to your lecturer, NOT to your Recitation Instructor. (I (Matsuki) have received more than a hundred regrading requests over the past 10 years. There has not been even a single case where the computer made a mistake.)

Contents

- There will be total of 12 questions, 10 of which are worth 8 points and 2 of which are worth 10 points. The maximum possible score is:
 $10 \text{ questions} \times 8 \text{ points} + 2 \text{ questions} \times 10 \text{ points} = 100 \text{ points} .$
- In Exam 1, ALL the questions will be taken from the Example Problems in the Study Guide (with possibly different numbers, different functions, and/or in different wording etc.). We are revealing ALL the questions that could be on the real Exam 1 in the form of the Example Problems in the Study Guide for Exam 1. **No Surprise !**
