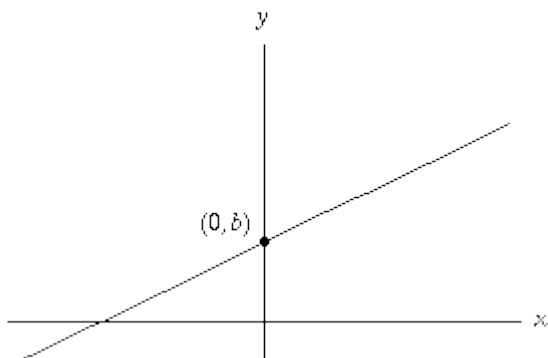
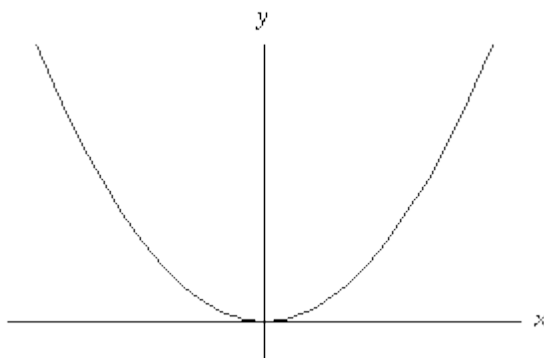

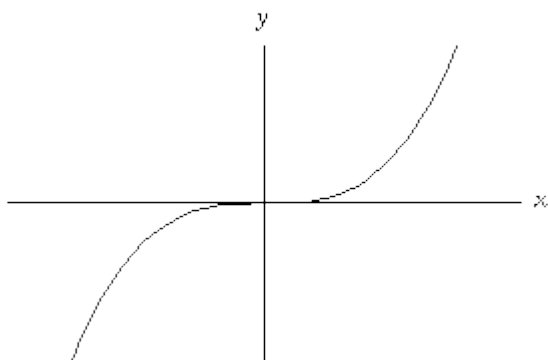
Common Graphs:



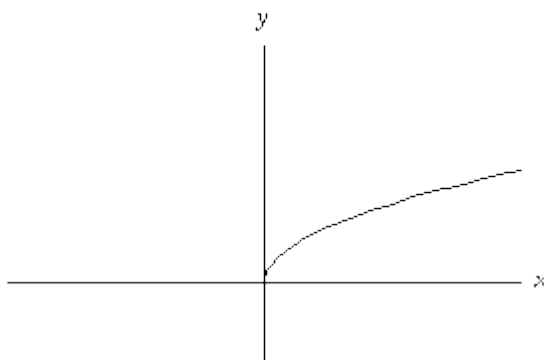
$$y = mx + b$$



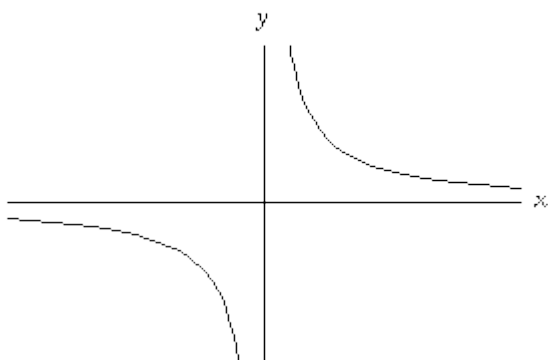
$$y = x^2$$



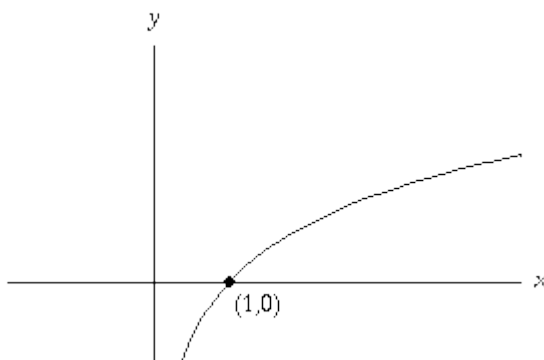
$$y = x^3$$



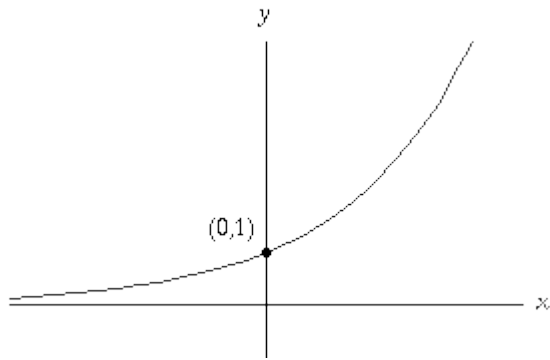
$$y = \sqrt{x}$$



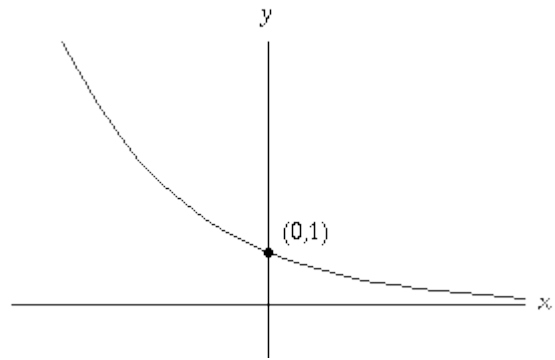
$$y = \frac{1}{x}$$



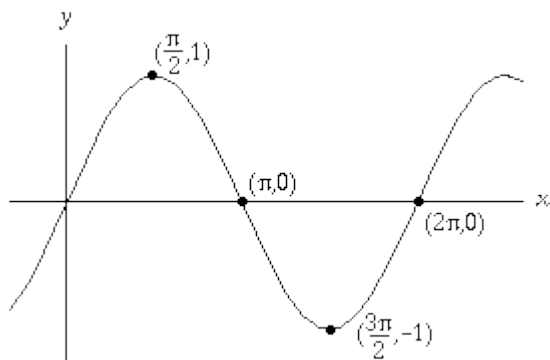
$$y = \ln(x)$$



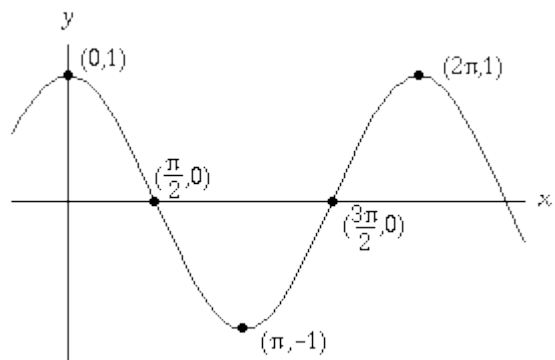
$$y = e^x$$
