

How to Access MATLAB

Below are some options for accessing MATLAB in order to do the MATLAB homework problems.

1. MATLAB is accessible from any ITaP computer. If you wish to use ITaP computers to work on the MATLAB homework, this is a simple option.

2. If you wish to work from your personal computer, you can download ITaP's GoRemote software.

IMPORTANT!!!

Whichever way you choose to access MATLAB...

There are MATLAB files on the course webpage (math.purdue.edu/MA265). You should download these files and put these files in a specific location, depending on which method you are using to access MATLAB.

1. If you are using ITaP computers, you should place these files in the "My Documents" folder after launching MATLAB.

2. If you are using ITaP's GoRemote software, under "Computer," you will find a file with your username. In that file, there will be a My Documents/Matlab folder after launching MATLAB. These files should go in that folder.

Without these files, you will not be able to do some of the MATLAB homework, so make sure you get these files.
